To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God. Micah 6:8b NIV

We looked at how the verse above links to our verse for the year in a recent service and approached it from the view of how we treat other people. Sometimes though we also need to think about how we're treating the world around us and whether our actions are 'just' in that regard.

We're fortunate in our area to still get weekly rubbish collections at the minute. But are we taking advantage of the easy recycling system that we have of most of it going into the pink sacks unsorted? Other areas have much more complex systems where you need to sort it first, so were are also fortunate in that regard.

When we're moving around the area are we walking when it is possible or using public transport rather than our cars?
