## A Tale of Two Cars - Dave

My work involves travelling around the UK delivering training. I spend a lot of time in my car. It was 9 years old and I loved it – I had it from new because my previous car had been old and involved in an accident and written off despite the damage being minor. With the write off value I bought it back, with money left to put towards the new car and exchanged the car under the government scrappage scheme.

Last month, I had admired a neighbour’s hybrid car and thought it would be great to have one. I then dismissed this thought, telling Jesus I was actually very happy with my car which had recently been serviced, was in excellent condition and running well.


Later in the week I was driving to see my mum with my wife, when on a straight section of road there was a strong gust of wind and the bonnet suddenly blew back on itself, opening completely, smashing the front windscreen and denting the roof and front wings. I couldn’t see the road ahead but was able to pull onto the verge and stop. On reflection, if this was going to happen it

could not have happened in a better place, as earlier we had been on a busy dual carriageway and it had been raining heavily. It was also local to where we live and not somewhere when I was working miles from home. The most important thing was that no one was hurt as a result.

Over the next month there were many problems replacing the car e.g. written off, declared repairable then finally written off, a hire car was provided but there were problems with payment, I found a new hybrid car which my son in law told me about, but there were problems registering it but I was provided with a courtesy car and also my wife’s car broke down on another attempt to visit my mum.

However, my daily Bible readings on the free ‘Bible in One Year’ app (BIOY) every day had something that directly related to my situation and encouraged me to put my trust in God and wait patiently knowing that He would provide what I needed. One of the daily headings ‘No blessing goes uncontested’ told me to trust God through troubles, attacks from the enemy and all circumstances because He is faithful and worthy of our trust.

I am now blessed with a new hybrid environmentally friendly car with additional features I had wanted but never asked for and were not shown on standard specifications. It is just ideal for my work around the country. God doesn’t always give us what we want but He promises He will provide what we need – we need to let go and trust Him realising that there will be troubles but He will be with us through them.
