Buildings and facilities to be inviting and attractive, and easily accessible for those with physical disabilities.
Having a secure entrance, and either an internal porch for parents to wait, or a sheltered, well lit area outside would be good.
Accessible entrance for disabled people needs consideration.
Display boards inside for groups to use. Display boards outside to share updates/ advertise groups.
To include Storage space for the church and groups. If groups could avoid going into the main Hall it could help limit the extent of work for setting up for services.
Could there be a smaller second room for anyone that needs a quiet space/ timeout.
Multiple storage cupboard would be great so a number of projects could share the use of the building without taking from each others needs. A toilet maybe good so as not to impact the church when the hall is being used.
A folding awning attached to the build would provide extra advantage, shade from 30 degree heat in the summer and unexpected showers in spring and autumn. The church has a beautiful setting it would be nice to enjoy the outside as well as the inside.
How much parking will be available?
It is an excellent idea to create a new building better able to serve the congregation, and the local community, more widely, and in a variety of ways.

Yes 2 storeys / car parking / we need Manor Mission to stay and come into the 21st Century to help all of Laindon

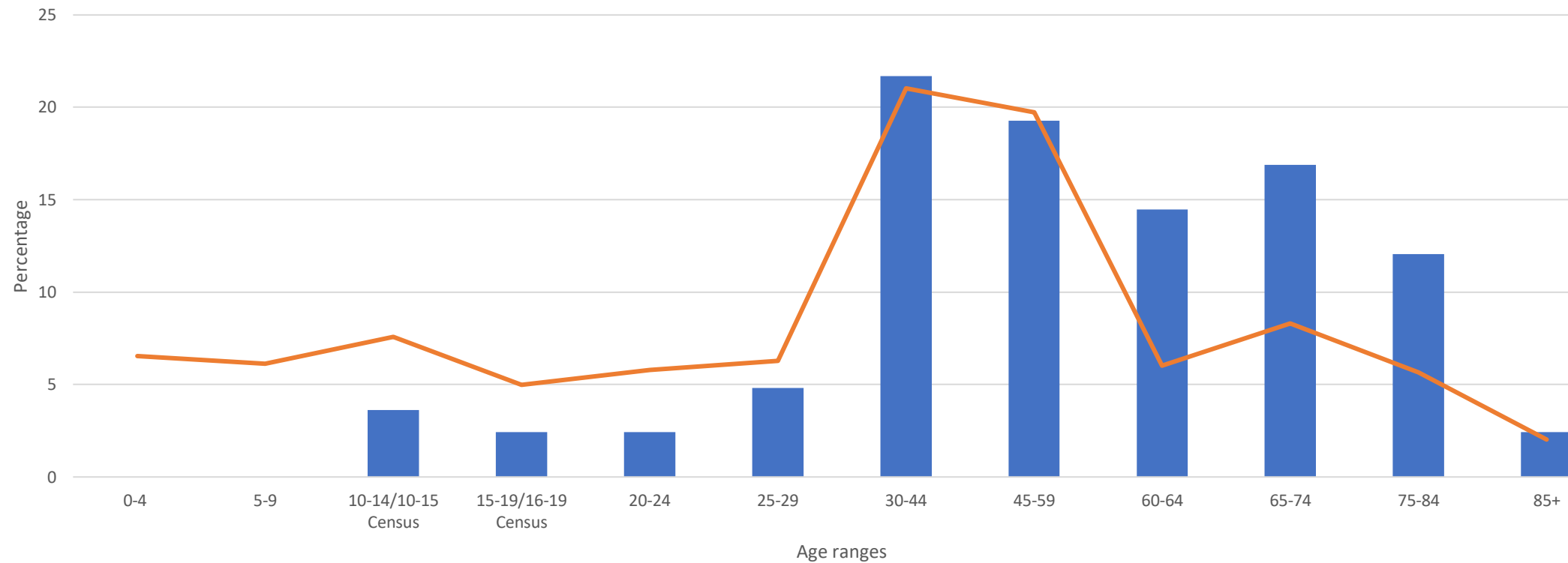
My only comment is that lets pray that by the help of God it will be a bit bigger and spacious. I thank you all for asking me to participate.

Why would anyone want to rebuild this depressing church?

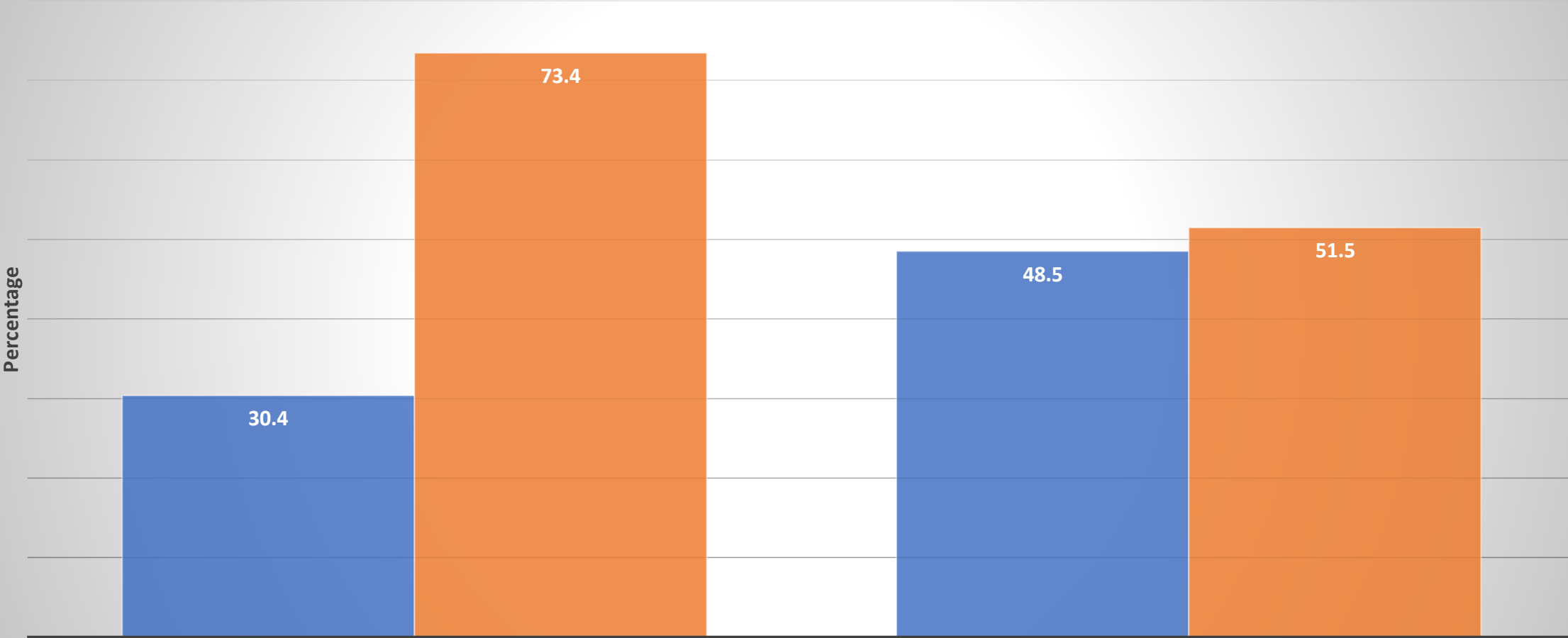

CONSULTATION PERCENTAGE

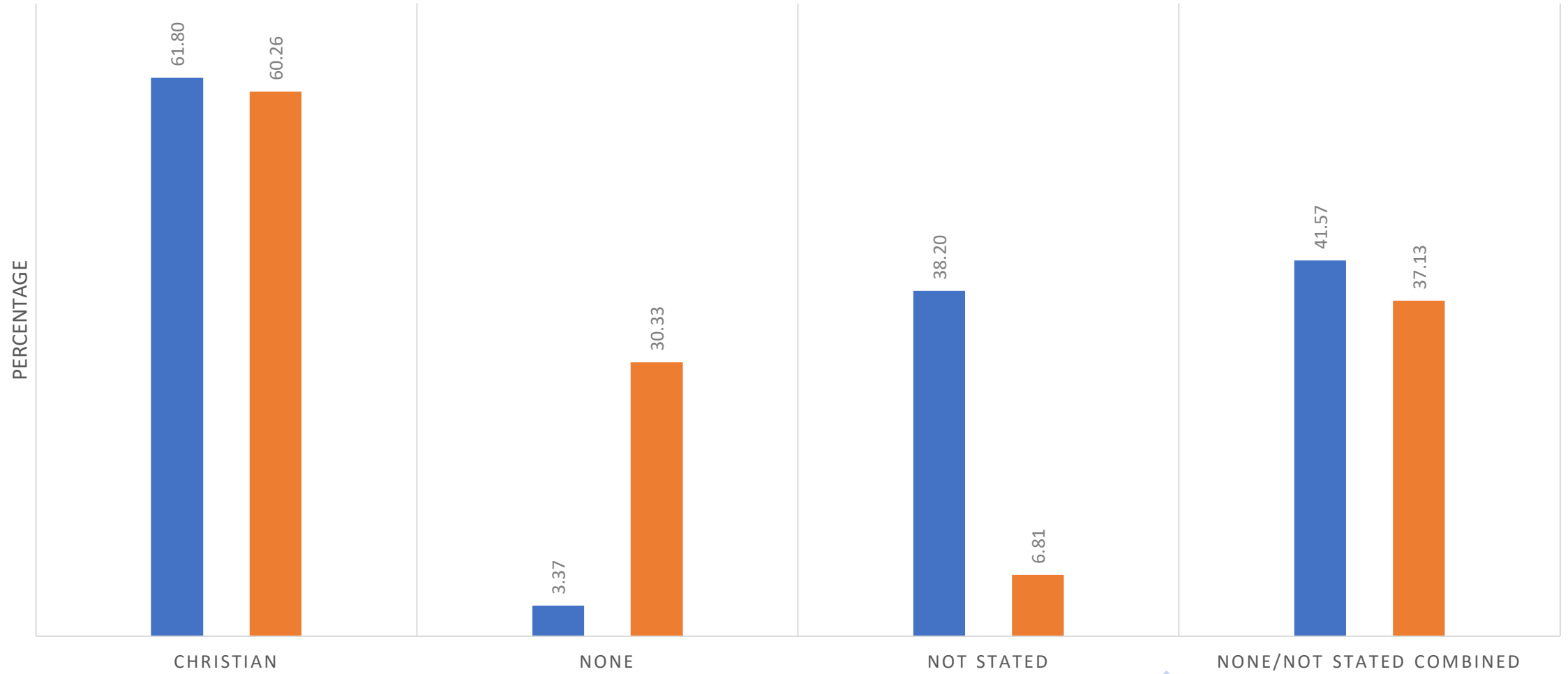
CENSUS PERCENTAGE

Male Female

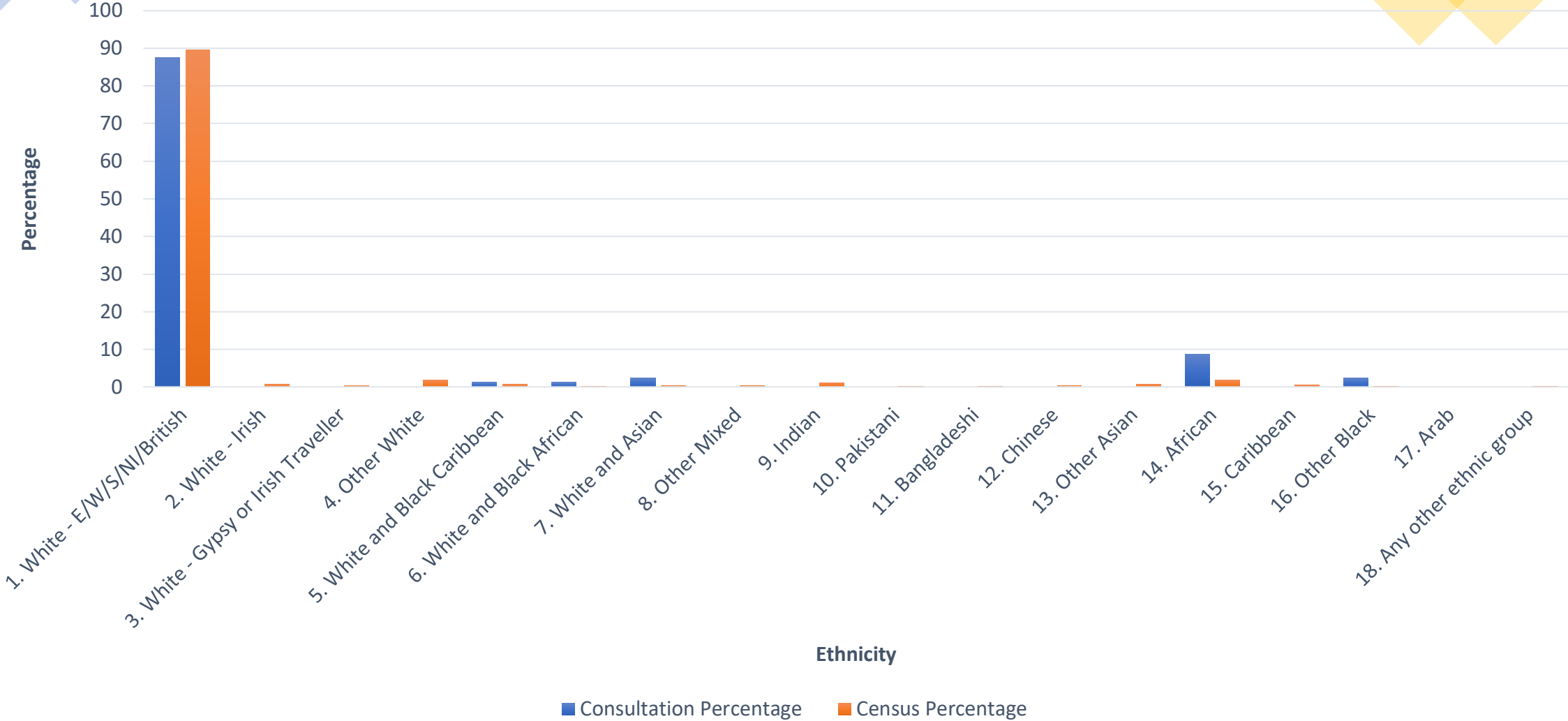
