A Happy Christmas to you all! May this month be full of seasonal cheer. We'll be hearing a lot about the birth of Jesus and celebrating at home and together at Church. But, then....what next? As 2022 limps to its close (unlamented by some), what will 2023 bring? I don't know - do you? Of course you don't!

Back in January 2020, I wrote in another magazine that, even if you've got 20:20 vision (see what I did there?), you can't predict what will happen as a New Year comes. Well, I got that right, anyway - within a few weeks, we were all in lockdown....

I guess a year ago you might have predicted that 2022 would bring a new King (the late Queen was 96, after all), but two new Prime Ministers? A year ago, there was suspicious activity on the Ukrainian border, but did any of us expect Russia to invade....and for the war to be dragging on so many months later? And in January, inflation was at 4.9% and we were starting to complain....now it's 11%. Did we see it coming? What about in your own lives this year? Your families? This Church?Any surprises? I'll be surprised if there weren't...!

If we could see the future, we would all be experts....and paralysed with fear. In 1 Samuel 28, King Saul was troubled. Things were going badly and God wasn't answering his prayers. Instead of examining his heart, confessing his sins and waiting for God, he consulted a medium (the famous Witch of Endor). He had trouble finding her because he had sensibly expelled mediums from the kingdom – thus adding hypocrisy to his other crimes. Did the witch tell him what he wanted to hear? No: she brought the prophet Samuel back from the dead who told him what he didn't want to hear – that the next day, he and his sons would die in battle with the Philistines....as indeed they did. Samuel was very cross with Saul for disturbing him. Quite right, too! The prophets and apostles have already told us all we need to know – it's all there in God's Bible. Even Jesus was content not to know every detail of the future when He was here on earth, but instead to leave it to God (Mt. 24:36).

So, as 2023 approaches, you don't need to go to the end of Southend Pier to see what "Mystic Meg" has to say – she's got no more idea than you! Instead, determine to use all the gifts and knowledge that God has given you and will give you to make it a good year for yourself and for others, too. But, most of all, remember what Jesus said:

I am with you always [in 2022 and 2023] and to the very end of the age (Mt. 28:20).
