

## Thank you, Thank you, Thank you – You're very welcome – No Thank You!

Thanking people is a two-way process – there needs to be someone to say, 'thank you' and someone to thank. In the old days there were often three stages 1. someone would write a letter about something, 2. the recipient would reply thanking them for their letter and answering it and 3. the original author would write thanking them for their letter. Nowadays with text messages and emails it seems stage 3 is often missed – it would be silly to thank people for thanking them for thanking them but perhaps we are becoming less thankful? On Sunday we looked at a Samaritan leper and a sinful woman who both gave thanks to Jesus (Luke 17:11-19, 7:36-50). On both occasions after Jesus had healed/forgiven them He in effect said thank you to each of them and did it publicly. He remarked on their faith in relation to their healing and forgiveness telling them to go in peace.

Thanks is mentioned a lot in the Bible, a regular phrase is 'Give thanks to the Lord, for His love endures forever' and often accompanied by exuberant praise e.g. 'The trumpeters and musicians joined in unison to give praise and thanks to the Lord. Accompanied by trumpets, cymbals and other instruments, the singers raised their voices in praise to the Lord and sang "He is good; His love endures forever." Then the temple of the Lord was filled with the cloud [God's Holy presence]' 2 Chron 5:13.

Thanks is an important constituent of praise. So, continuing the challenges from Sunday: Do we need to be more thankful to others? Do we need to be more thankful to Jesus? Do we need to be more extravagant with our thanks to both Jesus and others? Having given thanks listen out for the reply 'Thank you – go in peace' Thank you for taking the time to read this and thank you to Tim for editing and producing the magazine – it is really appreciated.
