

## Heather's Thought - Rediscovering Fellowship

We have been deprived of fellowship over the last 18 months due to the need to stay in our 'bubbles' and not to mix with many people. Socially distanced conversations, phone calls and zoom meetings have been a partial replacement. Now that we are able to mix more, looking at Fellowship again may be useful.

Fellowship is the relationship that we have with one another as Christians. It is based on the relationship we have with Jesus Christ.

When you and I became Christians, three relationships changed:

Jesus became our Saviour;

God became our Father;

The Church became our Family.

Believers are now our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Have a read of Acts 2: 41-47

1) Fellowship builds FRIENDSHIPS

The early church was a close-knit group and togetherness builds RELATIONSHIPS, Relationships build FELLOWSHIP (with T - I - M - E) and Fellowship builds FRIENDSHIPS with time, energy and effort.

Jesus said this about Friendship – John 15:15

2) Fellowship builds UNITY

The church is called to be united. Unity is having in common and being of the same mind.

See Psalm 133:1

3) Fellowship builds GOD'S KINGDOM

Our fellowship, the relationship we have with one another and with Jesus, is a witness to the world. The early church was committed to Jesus and to one another and the world saw it. When Christians regularly meet together to worship God and fellowship with one another, we are a witness to the world.
